Cherokee Purple sets giant beefsteaks weighing about a pound and filled with intense violet-purple hues. This is a true legacy plant, believed to have originated more than 120 years ago in the Cherokee Nation in Tennessee. Do Not Refrigerate.

VR Moscow (Heirloom, Indeterminant, Open Pollinated) -100 days to maturity after transplant **\$5.00**



This Heirloom tomato is an old variety that produces loads of larger tomatoes, not quite beefsteak size, but a nice big size. The VR Moscow has a bold, old-fashioned flavor. The Moscow VR Tomato (*Lycopersicon lycopersicum*), was developed especially for inter-mountain regions by USU (Utah State University) in 1952. It was named after Moscow, Idaho, not Russia. Thick skins make them ideal for canning. VR stands for "verticillium-wilt resistant." Do Not Refrigerate.
